Though our founder began a small medical foster for cats in 2010, the journey truly took shape in 2016, when a committed team came together. In 2018, Samovila Foundation was officially registered as a Trust, giving structure to our shared vision of compassionate animal care.

Today, we are a mid-sized home shelter for senior and handicapped community animals. Our focus remains on providing a calm, safe, and dignified environment for animals who would otherwise struggle to survive on the streets.

In partnership with Astha Animal Welfare Foundation, we also foster injured and vulnerable rescues from the Palghar area, supporting their treatment and recovery.
