HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR

- Continued fostering of injured and accident-affected cats and dogs from the Palghar area.
- Construction of a spacious, dedicated kennel for our paraplegic duo, Preet and Abhay, to improve their comfort and mobility.
- All resident dogs were vaccinated with:
 - 9-in-1 vaccine
 - Anti-rabies vaccine
 - Kennel cough vaccine

Samovila Foundation has continued its journey as a Loving Home for senior and handicapped community animals since relocating to Palghar in 2020. Over the years, our small, dedicated space has become a sanctuary for animals who would otherwise have nowhere safe to go. When the Trust was formed, the Trustees collectively chose the motto “Quality over Quantity.”

As a moving, gypsy-style shelter, our focus has always been to maintain a manageable number of residents so that, if relocation becomes necessary, our senior and special-needs animals are not subjected to stress or hardship. 
COMMUNITY & SUPPORT

- Hotel Yuatcha organized a special event and pledged part of the proceeds to our Home.


Their support brought both financial relief and emotional encouragement to our team.
